A Parent's Right to Know!

The Every Student Succeeds Act gives you have the right to request and receive (in a timely manner) the following information:

- Whether your student's classroom teacher has met State qualifications for grade level and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction;
- Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or other professional status that the State has waived;
- Whether your student is provided services by paraprofessionals and if so their qualifications;
- Notice if your student has been taught for 4 or more consecutive weeks by a teacher who does not meet State certification or licensure requirements for that grade level and/or subject area;
- Notice of any assessment mandated by the State that your student must participate in and assessment results;
 and
- Notice of any local assessment that your student will participate in and assessment results.
