

State Testing

Grade 3- BOG Reading Test is administered at the beginning of the year and serves as baseline data to establish student growth in reading included in the states' accountability model.

The Read to Achieve program for 3rd graders requires students to reach proficiency in 3rd grade reading standards by the end of their 3rd grade year. The students have several opportunities to demonstrate proficiency including; 3rd Grade BOG, EOG, Read to Achieve Spring, Reading to Achieve Summer, MAP Testing and 4th Grade Read to Achieve Fall.

Grades 3-8 EOG Reading and Math, Science 5 and 8 tests are administered in the last 10 days of school to measure grade level proficiency based on state standards. Included in the states' accountability model proficiency and growth is the NC Extend 1 test results for students that are tested in the Extended Content standards.
