

THE LEARNING CENTER! Authority of School Personnel

The board is committed to providing a safe, orderly, caring and inviting school. It supports administration's efforts in creating and enforcing policies and procedures that establish expected standards for student behavior, determining consequences for prohibited behavior, and managing student misbehavior.

School administrators have the authority and responsibility to establish policies and procedures relating to student conduct, dress, and any other school standards, to communicate the policies and procedures to students and parents through the Student Handbook, and to investigate and take appropriate action when the policies and procedures are not followed.

The teacher has the responsibility to manage student behavior at any time the students are under his or her supervision. The teacher is expected to implement all policies and procedures regarding student conduct and dress and to report to administration any student whose behavior does not comply with established protocol.

Students and parents are expected to comply with all policies and procedures established by the school during school hours, afterschool or extra-curricular activities or at any on or off campus school sponsored event.
